Getting Started on VSee Video Conferencing

During the COVID-19 pandemic I am meeting with my clients via VSee video conferencing.

You will need to install VSee on your smartphone, Mac or PC and create an account. VSee has several products. You want VSee Messenger. It is free.

First, you must download VSee Messenger and create an account. Then, I will invite you to be a contact. Once we are VSee contacts, I can invite you to join a video conference session.

Step 1. Download and install VSee Messenger

- a. For Apple iPhone or iPad, download VSee Messenger from the App Store.
 - b. For Android phone or tablet, download VSee Messenger from the Google Play Store.
 - c. For Mac or PC, in your web browser, search on "vsee getting started" and select the first result, "VSee". You should land on the webpage, "https://setup.vsee.com/getting_started".
- Or, you could copy the web address(URL) and paste it into the browser.

In any case, regardless of the device, follow the online instructions to create a VSee account. To create a VSee account, you will need to enter your email Id as your VSee ID and create a password.

Step 2. Let me know you have created a VSee account. I will invite you to be a VSee contact.

Step 3. Accept my invitation to be a contact on VSee.

Step 4. Once you are my VSee contact, I can invite you to join me in a VSee video conference.

That's it.
